

Lesson Plan - 'My New Journey'

Activities and Lesson Plan

- **Pre-event activity:** (Individually)
Complete the risk diary.
- **Part 1:** (Whole class – Whiteboard activity)
Review and discuss the risk diaries.
- **Part 2: Survey:** (Individually)
Ask students to complete the survey 'How Safe is Your Journey to School?' (Refer to the Teacher Guidance Notes for how much help to give).
- **Part 3:** (Groupwork – group students according to their home area and/or feeder primary school, if possible, and ability if necessary)
Look at bus/train timetables – do the activity cards (bespoke activity cards – see Teacher Guidance Notes - asking pupils to plan the journey described on the card).

Look at maps of the local area and work out the safest route to School (preferably from home).
- **Part 4:**
Take a walk (or bus-ride) in the locality of the School, comparing the hazards/safe places spotted on the maps to the actual ones encountered.

- Survey sheets (How Safe is Your Journey to School?)

For follow-up work:

Look at cycle routes to your Secondary School.

*You will also need paper, pencils, coloured pencils, and helpers to meet adult : child ratios for the walk/journey (+ organise consent forms).
